Preferred Order of Hazard Control Methods

Reliability of a hazard is measured by the ranking of the strategy on the hierarchy of control. The higher the strategy, the more reliable and more cost effective the control will be. The space within the triangle represents the effort that should be put into developing the type of strategy (its desirability). The area outside the triangle but inside the rectangle represents the opportunity for failure of the control. The ranks of the particular solution on the hierarchy are given in the OHS summary of each solution.
